- You are responsible to **\*\*submit your music, video, and/or media show by Monday, April 7 to Mrs. Olds\*\*** in correct format & length for show. If you need an accompaniment track, it is your responsibility to find and purchase it. If you need help cutting music, please let Mrs. Olds know ASAP!
  
- Auditions should be conducted with **props and apparel/costume you will wear for the show**. We expect that you have practiced and that **\*\*you will perform your entire act in costume during auditions\*\***. We **DRESS UP** for our performance. Unless specific casual attire is essential for an act, performers should **NOT** wear jeans, t-shirts, sweatshirts or casual wear.
  
- Following your audition, please plan for us to offer you constructive feedback, including ideas to enhance your act for our specific audience/venue.  
**\*\*Expect that you may be called back to audition a 2<sup>nd</sup> time if you are asked to incorporate any changes, additions, or improvements.\*\***

**NOTE: After-school or in-school stage time to practice your act must be scheduled through Mrs. Tangi Olds. She schedules stage time for all Follies acts.**
